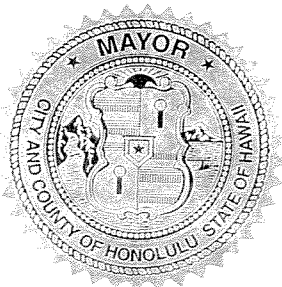

WHEREAS, the City deeply appreciates the valuable contributions and stewardship of the Earth Month sponsors and education and outreach partners,


NOW, THEREFORE, I, MUFI HANNEMANN, Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu, do hereby proclaim April 2010, to be
